***Jazz & Colors: Wave That Flag* to take place at The Field Museum in Chicago - July 4th, 2015, celebrating “The Great American Songbook” of the Grateful Dead**

Following the success of *Jazz & Colors* in New York’s Central Park and *Jazz & Colors: The Masterworks Edition* at the acclaimed Metropolitan Museum of Art, *Jazz & Colors* comes to Chicago’s Field Museum with a more focused and intimate experience. In conjunction with the 50th anniversary of the Grateful Dead, and 3 sold-out shows at Soldier Field, *Jazz & Colors: Wave That Flag*, will feature local jazz musicians performing in various parts of the Museum taking on the songbook of the Grateful Dead for 2 sets of music on Saturday July 4th, 2015 (12:30pm and 2:00pm).

Jazz & Colors is a co-production with The Field Museum, and *Fare Thee Well* promoters Peter Shapiro and Madison House Presents.

Ten jazz ensembles will fill the rooms of the museum as visitors become immersed in the music and art. Throughout the museum, visitors become audience members, and experience a range of jazz artists as they play their interpretations of the same program, simultaneously, in different galleries.
